We are seeking an enthusiastic, experienced Clinical Psychologist or Counselling Psychologist with leadership experience, to join us as **Clinical Lead on a 9-12 month maternity cover contract**.

The Clinical Lead is a vital role within IYC. Working predominantly remotely and as a key member of our senior leadership team alongside me, you will hold governance oversight and clinical decision-making responsibility for our organisation.

The primary focus of this role centres on leadership, management, and supervision. You will manage a dedicated team of clinical specialists and honorary assistant psychologists (APs) delivering our unique intervention. Additionally, you will oversee our termly referral management periods, maintain project oversight, and provide direct individual and group supervision to our clinical staff.

This is an exciting opportunity for a specialist who is:

- **Passionate & Impact-Driven:** Eager to make a meaningful difference in the lives of young Londoners and their families who have often been let down by local services and struggle to access traditional talking therapy.
- **Adaptable & Autonomous:** Comfortable working in non-clinical settings, balancing clinical and supervisory functions with operational and administrative tasks, and operating with a high degree of self-direction.
- **A Fast Learner:** Quick to understand our model, including shadowing project delivery during induction, to effectively support, supervise, and guide our growing team.

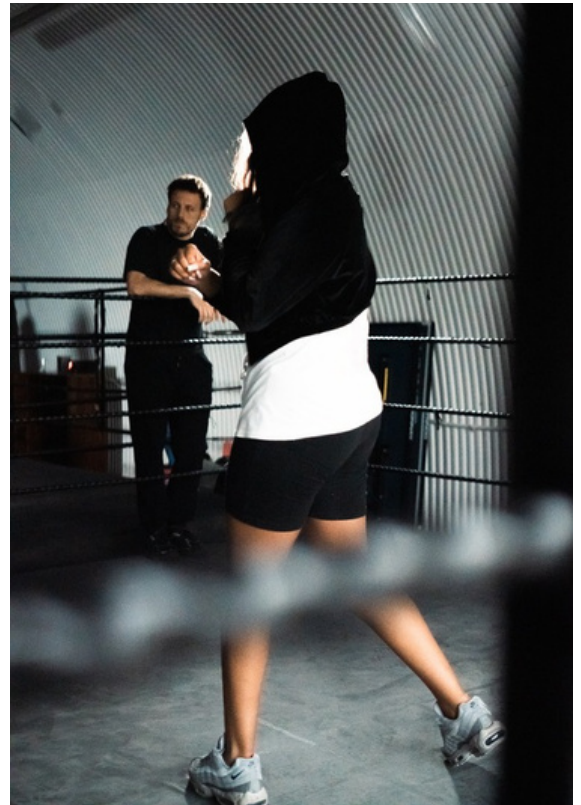


The Role

The role of Clinical Lead at In Your Corner is an exciting and fulfilling maternity cover post, well-suited to an individual with a proven track record of dynamic, high-quality, and innovative clinical leadership who is passionate about creating change for young people.

We are looking for someone who can offer continuity while bringing fresh ideas and innovation to our evolving charity.

This role is a great fit if you want to apply your clinical leadership and governance expertise within a small, agile organisation committed to developing practice-based evidence. Working closely with our senior leadership team, clinicians, boxing coaches, and community partners, you will play a vital role in supporting our unique model and shaping the lives of young Londoners.



Role: Clinical Lead (Maternity Cover)

Reporting to: CEO

Vacancy type: 9 - 12 Month Contract From Appointment

Working Hours: 0.4 WTE. 15 hours a week over 2 or 3 days, Tuesday to Thursday. Must include core project delivery times of 4.00 pm – 6.45 pm on some days worked.

Location: Predominantly Remote. In person working in Inner London locations is required. Other activities can be completed via remote working or in our Central London office.

Remuneration: £50,000 - £54,000 (pro rata) per annum, depending on experience. Plus 3% contributory pension scheme.

Probation: 12 weeks.

Role Responsibilities

- **Clinical leadership** and oversight of all clinical and project work undertaken at In Your Corner, in line with the organisation's strategic objectives, and key performance indicators.
- **Referral Management** of new projects to ensure groups are fully subscribed. Managing relationships with referral networks and supporting Clinical Specialists during assessment sessions and project launch.
- **Project Delivery Oversight** of all project groups to maintain high fidelity across all team members and settings. Ensuring adherence to best practice guidelines and leading on continuous development of the model and theory of change.
- **Line management** of project teams, including recruitment, onboarding and induction of clinical staff. Ensuring teams maintain consistent and effective performance via monitoring clinical KPIs.
- **Clinical Supervision** of project groups and individual supervision of all clinicians and honorary assistant psychologists. Liaise and maintain schedules of external supervisors.



Person Specification

- Post-graduate qualification and current professional registration in a core child mental health profession e.g. Clinical Psychology (D. Clin. Psych), Counselling Psychology (DPsych), or Senior Psychotherapist (BABCP or BACP).
- Robust knowledge of theory and research that underpins working with adolescents with complex mental health difficulties, including those who have experienced trauma, adversity, and social exclusion.
- Strong organisational and planning skills - this role involves managing competing priorities across a varied workload.
- Line Management experience - supporting clinicians, conducting performance reviews and support with recruitment.
- Clinical governance skills, including clinical supervision, safeguarding, risk management and quality assurance.
- Excellent data management and analysis skills.
- A high degree of autonomy and self-direction is essential.
